# FedEx Ground Over the Road Line Haul Service



## FEDEX GROUND OVER THE ROAD LINE HAUL SERVICE

We continue to provide Package & Delivery (P&D) services for FedEx Ground throughout Nashville and surrounding areas and since our start in March 2013, Vanquish has increased our workload substantially, now perform over 34% of all daily P&D services out of the Nashville terminal.

In early 2014 we expanded our services for FedEx and kicked off our over the road line haul transport from Nashville and Memphis to hub locations across the U.S. Vanquish Worldwide was assigned its first Line Haul on February 3, 2014 for dispatch the next morning from the Nashville terminal. The assignment was a two leg round trip taking a set of doubles to a location just east of St. Louis, Missouri and exchanging with a second set to return to the Nashville hub. On the return trip, freezing rain, sleet, and heavy snow were encountered which made interstate travel challenging along the Illinois-Kentucky border continuing into Clarksville, TN. As always, our experienced drivers kept safety in the forefront and were able to travel through at a steady pace returning to the Nashville terminal just after 1430 where our staff was informed that we were the only carrier that made it back from the northern region where weather conditions worsened through the night.

“The safe and successful execution of our Line Haul service is just another example of Vanquish’s dedication to DELIVERING EXCELLENCE in our daily work” stated Jon Helpingstine, Vanquish’s FedEx Transportation Manager. Vanquish’s current contracts with FedEx Ground total over \$5.4 million with future revenue growth expected to exceed \$10 million by the end of 2014.

## Peak Technical Institute's Commercial Driver License (CDL) Training at Colorado Campus

In March of 2014 Peak Technical Institute (PTI), kicked off its Class A Commercial Driver (CDL) training program and Comprehensive Oil & Gas Safety Awareness training at the Loveland, Colorado campus.

The CDL training is designed to introduce students to industry procedures and requirements, while they obtain the required skills and fundamentals to safely operate a commercial vehicle. With PTI's solid reputation in occupational training and expert commercial driving instructors, the CDL course will allow students to become professional truck drivers in as little as three (3) weeks of specialized hands-on and behind the wheel training.

Each course consists of classroom and on-the-road experience to ensure the best possible training and a bright new career for students. At the Colorado campus we have ample classroom and driving facilities where students learn and then practice the skills necessary to obtain a CDL. PTI's fleet of 2010 International Pro-Stars tractors -trailers is used exclusively for student training and testing.

In addition to the CDL program which is based on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) "Model Curriculum", PTI offers a Comprehensive Oil & Gas Safety Awareness Program for drivers choosing to work in the thriving oil & gas industry. This two day course includes: Hydrogen Sulfide Awareness, PEC Basic Orientation, and OSHA 10-hour General Industry training certificates.



# CDL TRAINING



In the spring of 2014 PTI's CDL program was approved for Post 9/11 VA Education Benefits. Now our country's heroes can take part and earn vocational certificates for little or no out of pocket cost and start a profitable career in trucking and oil & gas industries.

At PTI's Colorado campus, new CDL classes begin every other week through 2014. PTI has been approved and is regulated by the State of Colorado, Department of Higher Education, Private Occupational School Division in Colorado. PTI currently has an application in for approval by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission (THEC) for both the CDL and Personal Household Management (PHM) training programs. Pending approval, CDL classes will begin in late August 2014 at PTI's head-quarter location in Maryville, Tennessee.

## DOMESTIC GROUND FREIGHT CARRIER SERVICE SUPPORTING US ARMY'S SURFACE DEPLOYMENT AND DISTRIBUTION COMMAND (SDDC)



In addition to commercial trucking, during the first quarter of 2014 Vanquish began work as a DoD Domestic Ground Freight carrier in support of the US Army's SDDC. The SDDC's primary focus is supporting the Warfighter. Whenever and wherever Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, Marines and Coast Guardsmen are deployed the SDDC is involved in planning and executing the surface delivery of their equipment and supplies 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

For the SDDC, Vanquish provides origin-to-destination surface movement of DoD equipment and supplies to military bases and facilities across the US and throughout Canada. Additionally, our goal over the next few years is to grow our scope of services for the SDDC by transporting materials designated as protected or sensitive under the Government's Transportation Protective Services (TPS) and Arms, Ammunition, and Explosives (AA&E) program.

## EAGLE BOA CONTRACT WITH US ARMY



In March 2014, Vanquish was awarded a 3-year Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) under the Enhanced Army Global Logistics Enterprise (EAGLE) Program. Vanquish joins over 100 BOA holders, both large and small businesses, to compete in providing the Army with logistical support in the functional areas of supply, maintenance and transportation. Based on Vanquish's extensive background in these functional areas and excellent project performance over the last seven years, we were approved as a prime contractor in all three areas. Vanquish also underwent and successfully completed a pre-award Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA) accounting audit in order to qualify as a BOA holder.

The EAGLE BOA, valued at over \$23 billion, is used by the Army Material Command to expedite global logistics. BOA holders will provide services relating to CONUS and OCONUS operations in logistical readiness centers, the Army's prepositioned stocks program, and other logistical support services required by Army customers. Services will be performed at military installations in the US, Kuwait, Japan, Afghanistan, and other locations around the world.

"With our extensive experience working with the US Army supporting soldier deployment activities and managing logistics and supply chains, as well as transporting all classes of cargo from installations and forward operating bases across the world, Vanquish can ensure successful execution of US Army missions," said Eric Barton, President and CEO of Vanquish Worldwide. "We understand the Army's logistical needs and have the skills and expertise to be a high performing prime in this effort."

## OPTIONS/ EXTENTIONS

In addition to winning new contracts and ramping up our commercial trucking operations, in early 2014 Vanquish has been awarded multiple option period extensions on our current government contracts. Option period one has been executed for EPA Region 10 Warehouse Services and Flight Line Vehicle Maintenance contracts which run through May 5th 2015 and May 23rd 2015, respectively.

In addition, we are currently working under contract option periods for National Afghan Trucking and US Army Garrison –Hawaii Mob/Demob contracts which run through mid to late June 2014.



With this level of amputation, Cody had been having to walk using two canes. With Willie's help, he can now walk using only one cane. This is amazing.

But his help doesn't stop there, Willie knows certain things by their name such as keys, cane, and leash. If Cody is walking, or even if he is in his wheelchair, and drops something, he just has to tell Willie and he will pick it up for him. This is a tremendous help especially if he is walking or in one room and needs an item from another room.

Willie can go get the item for him and he can also give him an item, tell him to take it, and Willie will take it and put it somewhere for Cody.

Cody is now in college and Willie attends classes every day with him; he is very well behaved and people have even said that they didn't know he was there until class was over and saw him.
